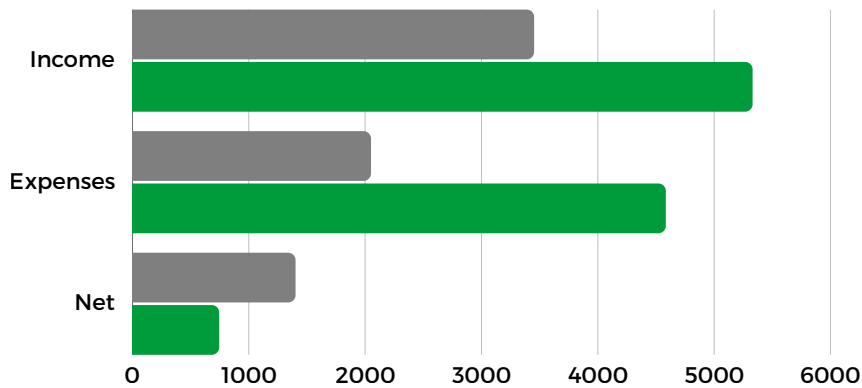

The below data depicts the fiscal activities of Alphonso Scholarship Foundation, Inc. for the 2024-25 fiscal year.

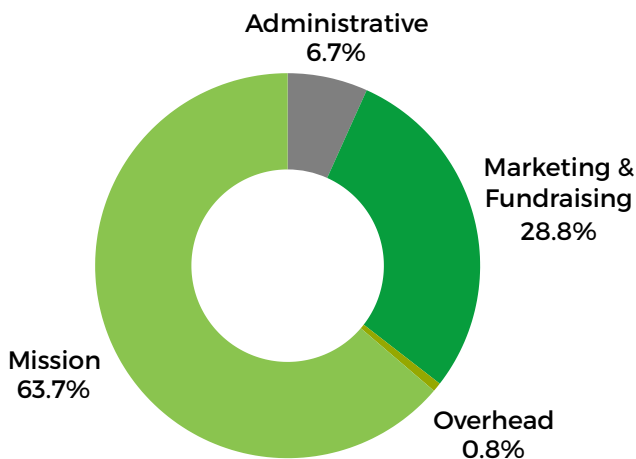

Each initiative reflected our commitment to strengthening community wellness, expanding access to essential resources, and meeting families where they are with meaningful support.

PARTNER HIGHLIGHT



ASF had the honor of supporting the Family Resource Center's Annual Health and Wellness Fair! This community-focused event provided free access to a wide range of health screenings, family activities, and interactive demonstrations. Highlights included a hands-on juicing class that showed families how to incorporate fresh fruits and vegetables into a balanced diet, as well as personalized fitness training led by a certified personal trainer for participants with mobility challenges.

The fair also welcomed more than 22 community partners and agencies, each offering valuable resources and information. Families had the opportunity to learn about childcare options, developmental screenings for children, free contraceptives, health insurance enrollment, colorectal cancer screenings, and much more.
